- 2. If applicable, official evaluation of international transcripts
- 3. If required by department, official documentation of Master's degree

NOTES

- **999 Registration deadline:** Students must be advanced to candidacy by the advancement semester add deadline in order to register for 999 that semester. If the add deadline has passed, students must wait until the following semester to register for 999.
- Students whose advancement date is extended, with Dean and/or Vice Provost permission, will have their
 graduation deadline reduced proportionately.
- Students working on dissertation research (999) must register for a minimum of 3 credits of 999 per semester (excluding summers) until they have completed the minimum number of credits of 998 and 999 required by the university and their degree program. Then, they must register for 1 credit of 999 until the dissertation is complete and has been officially submitted to the library.
- The **Non-Course Requirements** worksheet, page 2, must be completed at time of Advancement to Candidacy. Please list all exams, portfolios, proficiencies or other requirements for candidacy that are required by your program.
